International Players: Must produce documentation of the National Ranking at time of entry if they do not hold

an ATP/WTA ranking. Their status on the acceptance list is at the discretion of the

Tournament Director/Referee.

Players may not enter two tournaments that are conducted at the same time, unless there is a possibility that they will not be accepted into one of these. They must withdraw from one once the acceptance lists are determined. Players are responsible for ensuring they

effectively communicate with tournaments regarding these situations.

Doubles pairs are required to sign-on on-site on the first day of the tournament (first day of Main Draw), closing not before 12pm. Doubles matches may be played on Day 1.

Internet: All AMT's will be conducted with the Tournament Planner software allowing them to be

published on the Internet at <u>www.tennis.com.au/wa</u> à <u>WA Tournaments</u> à scroll down

Scheduling: In normal circumstances, players should not be expected to play (per day) more than 6

sets of singles and 4 sets of doubles. Breaks between matches should be in accordance

with normal procedures.

Seedings: In accordance with the AMT Procedures & Regulations, seedings will be prepared by

Tennis Australia.

Wild Cards: Wild cards are to be determined by the National Selectors of the applicable State/Territory

in consultation with the Tournament Director.

Lucky Loser: Lucky Loser and Alternate Sign-Ins will take place an hour before the scheduled start of

play at the tournament office and close ½ hour before the scheduled start of play for the

event.

Lucky Losers may be included in the draw if a vacancy is known during the week prior to Main Draw commencing, and they have signed-in (this may be over the phone). They may

also be drawn at the same time as qualifiers if a vacancy is available.

Online Entry:

Please follow the below steps to enter online:

- 1. Go to www.tennis.com.au/wa and at the top of the website, click on the 'WA Tournaments' link. Once you are at this page, scroll down to click on the tournament to navigate to the tournament page.
- 2. Once you are at the tournament home page, click the "click here to enter online" button at the top of the screen.
- 3. There will now be six steps in the entry process. The first step is to register for an account on the new entry system.
- 4. If you have an account, type in your login name and password (move to Step 7 if you have already registered for an account previously). If you don't have an account, click the "sign up" button. This will make online entry quicker in the future with all fields pre-populated when you login next time.
- 5. Choose your own login name and password (use the check availability button to see if your login name is available). Enter all your details carefully and when completed, click the "I accept" button to continue.
- 6. You should receive an instantaneous e-mail from Tournament Planner asking you to activate your account. If you do not click this link within 24 hours of receiving the e-mail, your account will be removed.
- 7. Now that you are registered for an account, type in your login name and password and click the "login" button.
- 8. Click the link to enter with your current account.
- 9. Read the regulations for the tournament and click the "tick box" at the bottom of the screen to agree to the entry conditions and continue to the next step.
- 10. Complete further entry details for the event. To have these fields automated for next time, click the tick box to update your profile with this information. Once you have completed all fields, click the "continue" button.
- 11. Click the "continue with payment" button
- 12. Read and agree to the waiver and complete your credit card details. Please be aware that only VISA and MasterCard are the only credit cards accepted. Once completed, click the "finish my registration" button.
- 13. Depending on the speed of our connection, the payment should take between 10-20 seconds to process. Once this has been completed, you should receive two confirmation e-mails, one from Tournament Planner that the entry has been processed and one from Active.com confirming that the payment has been successful.
