Calendar of Events

It was the general opinion that the Ambassadors are in the best position to assume responsibility to complete the annual calendar.

Associations and clubs are encouraged to provide their own calendars to their respective Ambassadors so clashes can be minimised.

John Glynn to liaise with Eastern and Western Division Ambassadors to coordinate the way forward

Junior Masters Circuit (10/U, 12/U, 14/U, 16/U)

It was considered to be of paramount importance for our junior players that the Circuit which commenced in 2004 be continued, and in a round robin format, however, the Region Network did not have the capacity to physically conduct the Lead-in events in this coming season

Lead-in events were sanctioned for Sale in October, Maffra in November, Bairnsdale in December, and Lakes Entrance in February

Clubs are encouraged to set appropriate dates in these months as soon as possible and provide these dates to Linda McIntyre and Margaret Supplitt

It was further considered the most appropriate persons to take responsibility for the future conduct of each of the Lead-in events are our Club Professional Coaches who may choose to liaise with their Club Committee to ensure the event is conducted in the best manner

> Division Ambassadors are asked to liaise with Club Professional Coaches of the four clubs to encourage their best conduct of these events

John Glynn agreed to maintain the Progressive Points Standings in the upcoming season should one of the Coaches doesn't assume that responsibility

The Lead-in events will be followed by the Masters Finals in Bairnsdale in April 2013 conducted by a person approved by the Network Committee.

2014 Tennis Victoria Junior Cups & Associations Challenge
Approved dates and venues for Junior Cups are to be circulated by
Tennis Victoria shortly. It was reported the Associations Challenge has
been rescheduled away from the June Queens Birthday and the
approved date and venue remains under consideration

Future Region Pennant and/or Lightning Premiership
John Glynn reported that a survey of players in last season's GPL players showed that of the 46 participants, 30 would not have competed in any other Saturday local pennant had GPL not been played. This is a most concerning statistic for clubs with major ramifications in the absence of GPL this season

It was considered that Club Presidents are the most suitable persons to assume responsibility with the Network Coordinator for any possible development of such events, which should include juniors and seniors

Intra Regional Championships

Discussion raised concern that these ceased some years ago. Adam Feiner reported that some Regions are re-introducing Intra Regional Championships in their calendars, realising on the aspirational importance of such event

The meeting felt our Region Network did not have the capacity to reintroduce these Championships this season, but will keep them in mind for future seasons

David Downie subsequently suggested he liaise with Club Presidents in due course to explore interest in such events and general Network matters for the benefit of clubs and players
