

SOUTH AUSTRALIAN FULL SCHOLARSHIP

To be considered for selection players must meet three of the following criteria.

- Top 12 Australian Ranking for birth year.
- Singles Rd 16 in an ITF Group 3 or better. The equivalent points from a Group 4 or 5 ITF would also apply.
- (Boys only) Singles Quarter Finalist or better AMT Platinum
- (Girls only) Singles Semi Finalist or better AMT Platinum (Boys only) Progressed to final round of a Pro Tour singles qualifying event more than once
- (Girls only) Winning final round of a Pro Tour singles qualifying event more than once
- Two Main draw singles win over the period of these 3 events: Australian Open Junior Championship, Loy Yang Traralgon International or Optus 18's Australian Championship (Main Draw).
- Top 500 ITF Ranking.

SOUTH AUSTRALIAN PARTIAL SCHOLARSHIP

To be considered for selection players must meet three of the following criteria.

- Top 18 Australian Ranking for birth year.
- Singles Rd 16 in an ITF Group 4 and better or Singles Quarter Finalist in an ITF Group 5
- (Boys only) Singles Quarter Finalist or better AMT Gold
- (Girls only) Singles Semi Finalist or better AMT Gold
- (Boys only) Progressed to final round of a Pro Tour singles qualifying event
- (Girls only) Winning final round of a Pro Tour singles qualifying event
- One Main draw singles win over the period of these 3 events: Australian Open Junior Championship, Loy Yang Traralgon International or Optus 18's Australian Championship.
- Top 750 ITF Ranking.

Achieving the criteria requirements does not guarantee scholarship acceptance. The National Academy will then consider the following factors in making the final selections:

- National Competitiveness
- Current Training Program
- On court Behaviour
- Physical Testing Results
- School Reports if requested

SOUTH AUSTRALIAN FULL SCHOLARSHIP

To be considered for selection players must meet three of the following criteria.

- Top 12 Australian Ranking for birth year.
- Singles Quarter Finalist at a Nationals or better
- Singles Rd 16 or better in any ITF more than once
- (Boys only) Singles Quarter Finalist or better AMT Gold more than once per calendar year
- (Girls only) Singles Semi Finalist or better AMT Gold more than once per calendar year
- Participate in two National Championships (Main Draw Singles)
- *** Singles Winner of a Gold OJT in Metro SA or Metro WA
- *** Singles Finalist or better of a Australian Ranking OJT Silver or better event in Metro NSW, Metro QLD or Metro Victoria
- Top 1000 ITF Ranking.

**** Players cannot achieve this criteria at an Australian Ranking event that is played concurrent with an National Championship event of the same age group. (E.g. By playing a 14/U singles event whilst a 14/U Australian Championship event is being played)*

SOUTH AUSTRALIAN PARTIAL SCHOLARSHIP

To be considered for selection players must meet three of the following criteria.

- Top 18 Australian Ranking for birth year
- Singles Rd of 16 or better at a Nationals
- Singles Winner of a 1st Rd at any ITF
- (Boys only) Singles Quarter Finalist or better AMT Silver
- (Girls only) Singles Semi Finalist or better AMT Silver more than once per calendar year
- Participate in two National Championships (Main Draw Singles)
- *** Singles Finalist of a Gold OJT in Metro SA or Metro WA (Players in their 15th year qualify by reaching the singles semi final here)
- *** Singles Semi Finalist or better of a Australian Ranking event in Metro NSW, Metro QLD or Metro Victoria
- Top 1500 ITF Ranking.

**** Players cannot achieve this criteria at an Australian Ranking event that is played concurrent with an National Championship event of the same age group. (E.g. By playing a 12/U singles event whilst a 12/U Australian Championship event is being played)*

SOUTH AUSTRALIAN FULL SCHOLARSHIP /

To be considered for selection players must meet three of the following criteria.

- Top 4 ranking for birth year in State
- An ITF Ranking – must be achieved through singles
- Singles Rd 16 or better in a National Championship – (This is a compulsory Criteria that needs to be achieved)
- *** Singles Winner of a Gold OJT in Metro WA or Metro SA
- ***Singles Finalist or better of a Australian Ranking OJT Silver or better event in Metro NSW, Metro QLD, Metro Victoria
- Competed in 5 OJT events in the last 12 months, with at least two events being National Championships.

**** Players cannot achieve this criteria at an Australian Ranking event that is played concurrent with an National Championship event of the same age group. (E.g. By playing a 12/U singles event whilst a 12/U Australian Championship event is being played)*

SOUTH AUSTRALIAN PARTIAL SCHOLARSHIP

- *** Singles Finalist of a Australian Ranking event in ACT, Metro NT or TAS
- *** Singles Semi Finalist or better of a Australian Ranking event in Metro NSW, Metro QLD, Metro Victoria, Metro WA or Metro SA
- Competed in 5 OJT events last 12 months, with at least two events being a National Championship.

**** Players cannot achieve this criteria at an Australian Ranking event that is played concurrent with an National Championship event of the same age group. (E.g. By playing a 12/U singles event whilst a 12/U Australian Championship event is being played)*

To be considered for selection players must meet three of the following criteria.

- Top 4 ranking within the age brackets 00/01/02
- Singles Rd 16 or better in a National Championship – (This is a compulsory Criteria that needs to be achieved)
- *** Singles Winner of a Australian Ranking event within ACT (Silver OJT only), Metro NT (Silver OJT only) and TAS (Silver OJT only)
- *** Singles Finalist or better of a Gold OJT
- Competed in 5 OJT events in the previous 12 months, with at least one event being a National Championship. 2000 born Athletes need to compete in at least 2 National Championships. (Bruce Cup can be used as a National Championship)

**** Players cannot achieve this criteria at an Australian Ranking event that is played concurrent with an National Championship event of the same age group. (E.g. By playing a 12/U singles event whilst a 12/U Australian Championship event is being played)*

SOUTH AUSTRALIAN PARTIAL SCHOLARSHIP

To be considered for selection players must meet three of the following criteria.

- Top 6 ranking within the age brackets 00/01/02
- One singles main draw win at a National Championship; or three singles wins at the same National Championship
- *** Singles Finalist or better of a Australian Ranking event within ACT, Metro NT and TAS
- *** Singles Semi Finalist or better of a Australian Ranking event within QLD, NSW, VIC, Metro WA & Metro SA
- Competed in 5 Junior Australian Ranking events in the previous 12 months, with at least one event being a National Championship. 2000 born Athletes need to compete in at least 2 National Championships. (Bruce Cup can be used as a National Championship).

**** Players cannot achieve this criteria at an Australian Ranking event that is played concurrent with an National Championship event of the same age group. (E.g. By playing a 12/U singles event whilst a 12/U Australian Championship event is being played)*
