Selection criteria and process

Eligibility criteria

To be eligible for consideration, the nominee must:

- Be a current ANZ Tennis Hot Shots Coach and Tennis Australia qualified coach member
- Offer a program that includes three components:
 - Reflects the 'learning through play' philosophy
 - Use of modified equipment (e.g. smaller courts, racquets and low compression balls)
 - o Provides a developmental pathway with red, orange and green progressive stages
- Be actively involved in his/her club/facility in growing the game of tennis
- Actively seek and foster positive relationships with local schools and the general community

Part-time and full-time coaches may apply.

Nominees may self-nominate or be nominated by another person (note: if you self-nominate you will require a seconder to support your nomination)

Selection criteria
