

Junior Athlete of the Year Tennis Tasmania



Selection criteria and process

Eligibility criteria

- Nominees must be 18 years and under as at the end of the award period;
- Nominees must be a citizen of, or hold permanent residency on Australia.

Selection criteria

The selection panel will give consideration to the following in assessing and comparing nominees:

No.	Description
1	Commendable ranking level (ATP/WT/ITF/AR);
2	Demonstrated record representing club, school, state/country
3	Appropriate and commendable attitude in-line with our player values of Compete, Commit and Respect; and
4	Has complied with all rules and conducts set by Tennis Australia.

Note: The award period is from 10 September 2015 – 9 September 2016. Only achievements/details from this period will be considered by the panel

Selection process

All decisions in relation to the Junior Athlete of the Year award (including any questions in relation to eligibility) will be determined by the selection panel in its absolute discretion. All decisions are final, and no correspondence will be entered into.

Any matters which arise and which are not covered in this document will be determined by the selection panel in consultation with Tennis Tasmania management.

30 September 2016	High res images of finalist due to TT for event presentation	High resolution images of all nominees are required ASAP before 30 September. These will be incorporated into a package on the night.
15 October 2016	Tennis Tasmania Awards Night
