Country week is on once again and Tennis Geelong invites you to participate in five days of tennis at Creswick and at Ballarat Regional Tennis Centre. Country week will be held from **21**st **January to 25**th **January 2013.**

FORMAT: This year there are two age groups Under 19 A, B, C and Under 14 A, B, C. The age cut off date for each age group is 1st January 2013. Teams consist of 4 boys and 4 girls. In each match you will play one doubles and one mixed, and each day you will play 2 to 3 matches (this depends on the number of teams in your grade). Sets are first to 9 games with a tie breaker at 8 all or if 3 matches are played it will be first to 6 tie breaker at 6 all. You will play two days at each venue and then the finals are on Friday. Please note teams are selected by the committee. We do try to play friends together but due to bus travellers and numbers of parents attending we have to ensure that there are managers for all teams. This will influence the team structure.

FEES: The fee for Country Week this year will be \$40.00per player.

BUS: A bus service will again be provided as a cost of **\$15.00 per day**. Please indicate on the registration form if you require the bus. The registration and bus fee must be included with your registration form. **Please note** if you use the bus system any changes to your travel must be relayed to the bus driver or the bus co coordinator. This saves time looking and waiting for a traveller that has used another means of transport.

IMPORTANT: Tennis Victoria registration numbers must be included on the form.

WEATHER: On days of excessive heat or rain competition may be **cancelled**; this could be half way through the day. In this case the bus will come home early so all travellers on the bus must be ready to travel or notify a member of the committee or bus driver if they have made alternate plans.

Players will have the opportunity to meet the members of their team and well as their manager. Players can bring along their tennis racquets for a hit. A free sausage sizzle will be provided.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR ALL PLAYERS

Members of the junior committee have put a good deal of time and thought into the selection of teams to represent Tennis Geelong at Ballarat Country Week and thereby expect that all selected players will comply with the following Code of Conduct.

- The Junior Committee wish to give all players the opportunity to play for Tennis Geelong at Ballarat Country Week. There are a large number of juniors wishing to play, which means that some teams will have extra players.
 All Players will be asked to rotate during the week if in teams with extra players.
- Team managers in consultation with the committee are responsible for team selection up to and including all finals matches. The team manager's decisions are final in this regard, irrespective of the evaluation by interested parents on the various players' performances. Please support your Team Manager.
- 3. Good sportsmanship must be displayed <u>at all times</u>.
- 4. Verbal or physical abuse to, your team members, opposition players, spectators, officials or your equipment will not be tolerated for any reason. Failure to comply with the requirement may mean that the player will be automatically disqualified by the Junior Committee for the remainder of the week. **Please note:-** The venues are alcohol free.
- 5. Correct tennis attire, including footwear, **MUST** be worn when competing.
- 6. After completing your sets of tennis, please remember that some teams have yet to finish. Please respect their endeavours and do not call out, scream or generally be disruptive whilst sets are in progress.
