

My Tennis Profile Competition 2011 - Terms and Conditions

1. Information on how to enter this competition (the "Competition") forms part of these Terms and Conditions.
2. The Promoter is Victorian Tennis Association ABN 29 757 304 158 of AAMI Park, Olympic Boulevard, Melbourne, VIC ("Tennis Victoria").
3. Entry is open to Tennis Victoria financial players ("Members"), who qualify for entry as follows:

Members will automatically receive one entry into the competition after they log into and update their My Tennis profile during the Competition Period. Members must click on the 'update' button at the bottom of the screen and receive a message in red text at the top of the page that says 'your profile has been updated' to be entered into the draw.
4. The competition commences at 9:00am on Monday 8 August 2011 and closes at midnight on Sunday 4 December 2011 ("Competition Period"). Any members who log in and update their My Tennis profile after this time will be ineligible for the draw and no responsibility will be accepted for late updates.
5. Employees, contractors and Board Members of Tennis Victoria and their immediate families (spouse/partner, child or parent) are not eligible to enter this competition. All entries will remain the property of Tennis Victoria.
6. The prize is:
 - a. Four (4) adult tickets to the Day Session of Australian Open 2012 on Sunday 22 January at Hisense Arena.

7. The Competition draw will take place at the Tennis Victoria office (AAMI Park, Olympic Boulevard, Melbourne, Victoria 3000) at 10:00am (AEST) on Tuesday 6 December 2011 ("the Draw"). The prize winner will be the first valid entry drawn at random from the My Tennis profile update report. The Prize Winner will be notified in writing by Thursday 8 December 2011. The Prize must be claimed (but not collected) by Wednesday 14 December 2011 and the Winner's full name will be published in Hot off the Court on Thursday 15 December 2011.

In the event that the Prize Winner does not claim their prize by the time set out in clause 7, a subsequent draw will take place on Thursday 15 December 2011 at the same location and using the same random selection process ("Subsequent Draw"). The Subsequent Draw Winner will be notified in writing by Monday 19 December 2011 and their full name published in Hot off the Court on Thursday 19 January 2011. The Prize must be claimed (but not collected) by Thursday 22 December 2011.
9. The Prize is to be collected by the Prize Winner or the Subsequent Draw Winner from the Tennis

Victoria office (AAMI Park, Olympic Boulevard, Melbourne, Victoria 3000) by 5:00pm, Friday 20 January 2011. In the event that the Prize is not collected by this time, that aspect of the competition will be cancelled and there will be no Prize given.
