

2016 AUSTRALIAN OPEN ASIA PACIFIC WILDCARD PLAYOFF FACT SHEET



Overview	The Australian Open, Grand Slam of Asia-Pacific, is one of the largest and most prestigious sporting events in the world. Book your place to be there in January 2016 with the Australian Open Asia Pacific Wildcard Playoff (AWP) taking place in Shenzhen, China. Main Draw Wildcards are on offer for Asia-Pacific's winning Singles and Doubles tennis players.		
Eligibility	The AWP is open to all Nationals from the Asia-Pacific region, excluding Australians, with a World Ranking of 105 or higher for Men and 109 or higher for Women (based on the AO cut-off for Men of 104 and Women of 108) at the time of the entry closing. If anyone is ranked lower than these stipulated rankings and are concerned about any points they need to defend, you may contact the Tournament Referee for special exemption to play. There is no applicable cut-off for doubles so all Asia-Pacific players are eligible. However, the successful doubles pairs at the AWP must compete together at the AO. If this does not occur then the wildcard is no longer valid and will be returned.

Transport	 Tournament transport to and from tournament hotels and courts will be available from Sunday 29 November until Sunday 6 December 2015. Players are responsible for making their own way to and from the airport / train station. Transport inquiries can be made to: E: zyx@chinatennis.org.cn or T: +86 186 1831 0018. The main airport is Shenzhen Bao'an International Airport (SZX) located 32km from the city or you can fly to Hong Kong (HKG) and take the train to Shenzhen (approximately 1-1 ½ hours including immigration clearance into China). The taxi fare is approximately 150-200RMB (\$24-\$32 USD) from Shenzhen Airport to the hotel. 	
Accommodation and Official Hotels	 Main Draw players will be entitled to room only accommodation for a minimum of two nights including the night before the Main Draw begins until the night of their final match in the tournament. Qualifying Players should book at the official hotels directly and will receive the accommodation benefits upon reaching the Main Draw. ** VISAS **	All players require a visa and should contact the CTA (China Tennis Association) and Chinese consulate for information. A letter of invitation is required from Mr Lu Liang (CTA) and requests should be sent to Cheng Luotong (contact details below). You will need to provide the following; first and last names, passport number, nationality, issuing country, date of issue, date of expiry, scanned copy of photo page of passport, digital photo (passport), affiliation (player, coach etc.), arrival date and departure date.
