

## Division Grading Table

- Each division now has an even number of teams so there are no byes (subject to even team entries), creating a fairer more even competition as each division will have the same number of teams.
- 10 teams per division (up to division 6) so each team plays each other once. This is why your grading is subject to be in two divisions. For example if you played Division 1 Blue last season you could now be placed in Division 2 as a maximum of 10 teams can be in Division 1.
- You will mostly likely continue to play the same teams each season as they will be graded in the same division as you regardless of the division number.
