Equally, the competition environment through ANZ Junior pennant and The Walking Clinic Adult pennant allow players to feel a greater sense of belonging and a true connection to the club. We thank you for your continued support of these competitions.

The ACT and region continue to lead the way nationally with the innovative Book A Court system; allowing more players to access the sport via online booking and electronic gate access. With 20 clubs now utilising Book A Court a strong campaign was again delivered over summer which saw a huge increase in casual bookings and revenue generated for clubs. The ACT has more clubs per capita than anywhere in Australia using the system and well done to those who have continued the great work in this area. The numbers speak for themselves and we are seeing a big uplift in casual court hire. All our systems continue to be improved; we thank you all for the patience and feedback as we continue to work on making them better.

2018-19 saw bolstered community and club engagement at our major events. The Apis Canberra International, East Hotel Canberra Challenger and ACT Claycourt International provided unique activations such as Kids Tennis Day, Twilight Session and Girls Make Your Move Day. These initiatives showcased the world class tennis whilst leveraging participation. We held a club forum in conjunction with the East Hotel Canberra Challenger and hope those that attended enjoyed the VIP experience and chance to watch world class tennis. Your support of our club forums has been excellent and these are a great platform to continue to share ideas.
