

EXCELLENCE IN OFFICIATING

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for consideration, the nominee must:

- Be a current Tennis Australia Officials member
- Be 18 years or over at the beginning of the award period
- Be an Australian citizen or permanent resident

The Nomination Process for Australian Tennis

- The winners of the State Award Excellence in Officiating (or equivalent) will become a nominee for the National Award for Excellence in Officiating
- If a state/territory does not have an award in this category, the MA may nominate a candidate from that state/territory through the online portal, provided the nominee meets all the eligibility criteria
- The national body reserves the right to enter wild card nominees for this award.

Selection Criteria

The selection panel will give consideration to the following in assessing and comparing nominees:

- Outstanding contributions to tennis officiating in Australia and/or internationally through their dedication, skill, attitude and knowledge
- Performances that set them apart from their peers domestically and/or internationally
- Being a positive role model for other tennis officials
