

ACT JUNIOR CLUB PLAYER OF THE YEAR

The Junior Club Player of the Year recognises a player under the age of 18 who has demonstrated outstanding participation, consistent performance, and commendable attitude in line with our players value.

- Nominees must be 18 years and under as at the end of the award period
- Nominees must be a citizen or hold permanent residency of Australia.

Please supply a minimum of three high-resolution photos to support the nomination, including if possible, a head shot and an on-court photo of the nominee.

Selection Criteria

The selection panel will consider the following in assessing and comparing nominees:

- 1. Most participation in Tennis ACT competitions and events during the past 12 months
- 2. Most consistent performance in Tennis ACT competitions and events during the past 12 months
- 3. Appropriate and commendable attitude in-line with our player values of Compete, Commit and Respect
- 4. Complied with all rules and conducts set by Tennis Australia

PLEASE NOTE:

The *Junior Club Player* of the Year category is an ACT based award only. This award is not aligned with Newcombe Medal / Australian Tennis Awards, and therefore is exempt from the ongoing national process.
