Forfeit due to late Commencement of Play

Recently a team forfeited one set due to late arrival of players.

This is covered by rule 23 and 24 but is rarely enforced.

All teams should be able to commence the first set at 7.30. The rules state that this should be the first mixed but captains can agree to vary the order of play.

If you know some one will be a little late you should let the opposing captain know as soon as possible.

It is often possible to vary the order of play and avoid a late finish and lengthy breaks between sets.
