Finals Fill-in list

This finals fill-in list can be viewed at http://www.tennis.com.au/ayc/season

- The list displays all players eligible to play in finals. Any player on the list will be considered as approved to play as a finals replacement for any person above them on the list where it does not conflict with any existing Rules of the Association (Depending on the statistics, a player in Division 6 (as an example) may be listed below a player in Division 8 and this would make the Division 6 player eligible to play for that player in Division 8 even though it's 2 divisions below. Another example is where a Division 9 player is listed above a Division 7 player on the list This would make the Division 9 player ineligible to play in Division 7 for finals.)
- Teams may request a fill in outside the constraints of the list that will be considered by the Committee.
- The existing Rules of the Association regarding fill-ins for finals will remain in place. They can be viewed on the website at: http://www.tennis.com.au/ayc/rules
- Division 9 teams requiring fill-ins will be allowed to use players from other teams within Division 9 whom are not participating in finals. The list should still be consulted to find a player listed below the player to be replaced.
- If any Club is struggling to find an eligible fill-in for finals, please consult your Club representative in the first instance or alternatively email the committee.

When and Where to play finals matches

A query came through this week about matches and where they should be played. The following has been extracted from the rules, but should clear this up for those who may find themselves in this position.

- 35. (1) A finals match is to be played on the home court and on the home night of whichever team finished higher in the pennant
- (2) If, in the semifinal, the team that finished second in the pennant beats the team that finished first in the pennant, the grand final is to be played at the home court, and on the home night, of the team that finished second in the pennant.
- (3) If both teams agree, a finals match may be played on another night in the same week.
