As predicted, we had 4 person teams across all divisions and although we had some teething issues using Competition Planner it was great to have quite a few captains who persevered and entered results. Despite the issues, I hope everyone enjoyed the season.

Participation at AYC Championships grew in popularity again this season making these games competitive and fun social nights. A great opportunity to prepare for the season at no cost with a light supper thrown in.

After some non-attendances at the End of Season dinner, we'll need to introduce some type of prepayment to prevent the chasing up that occurs after the dinner to reimburse the AYC.

If I'm still in this position next season, I would like us to continue using Competition Planner and expect it to become easier for all of us as we learn more about it. I hope the incoming captains embrace it in the 2014/15 season. The application is free and can be used by clubs for their in-house competitions. I have heard Sorell are doing just that, so we should have a few experts soon. We still have a few issues to work through such as scoring, grading, some duplicate players (which is really showing another player with the same name) and a couple of missing names.

When the new season ramps up, we should have these things worked out and expect to be well placed to provide more information at the Captains meeting in September which is not restricted to Captains.

Tribute to Ean Cannell

Ean joined the AYC in 1953 and was President from 1959 – 1986. This was a time when the work was all done by hand and many long meetings were required to get the roster up and running for 70 to 80 teams. He had many successes on court including winning the A grade doubles on 2 occasions.

Ean always took a very considered approach to rule and rosters. He presided over the time when many of our current rules were established to ensure fair play, also at the time that the pennant was becoming Club based and when the best players in the south generally participated.

He was installed as a life member in 1972 at the Polish Hall in front of 240 players and friends.

He was also involved with National Fitness Council, the AYC parent body.

Ean played in the pennant for 50 years, happy just to be participating and was one of the few players who participated across every division of the pennant during his time. He often partnered his beloved wife Pat.

For many years Ean ran a small hobby business selling racquets and other tennis equipment and stringing racquets from a small room under his house. He served the needs of many local tennis players.

As a player Ean was a member of the Geilston Bay Tennis Club and played regularly, not only in the AYC pennant, but also in the now extinct Saturday afternoon pennant and South Eastern Districts Tennis Association events.

SPECIAL AWARDS

John Drake

John Drake was, for approximately 25 years the most prominent and active member of the Association. He held the position of Treasurer for all the period and served prominently on all Committees. He was elected a Life Member in 1973. John managed all the Young Liberals (later Liberals) teams, the name which is the only one to have competed in the A.Y.C competition for every year since its conception. Whenever anyone wanted a game John could always accommodate them in one of his teams. His interest in the Association was remarkable; often he would turn up at matches during the week, contributing for many years to "The Mercury" highlighting individual performance in matches. When John retired from playing he gave his racquet to a needy competitor and was known on many occasions to assist players experiencing personal difficulties. Sadly, John passed away in December 1984, this trophy has been presented annually since then to the person seen to be fulfilling John's ideals.

These teams were organised specifically to compete in this Association and went into recess for the off-season. John had suffered from diabetes from childhood, and night tennis was an activity that best suited this condition, unfortunately failing health later forced him to retire from competition but his enthusiasm for management and involvement remained.

SPECIAL AWARDS

Eric Wolfe

For approximately 20 years Eric Wolfe served as the delegate for the Northern Suburbs Club. This was the period when the A.Y.C Tennis Association consisted almost entirely of private social groups. Many players, who were introduced into the A.Y.C competition by Eric, later became prominent members of suburban clubs, which are now the major competitors in this Association. Their subsequent enthusiasm was, no doubt the result of the example set by Eric.

He served for many years on the Match & Tournament and Social Committees and always offered assistance in the management of the Championships, which included numbers in excess of 250.

Eric was renowned for his sportsmanship and gentlemanly court behaviour, with a game characterised by heavily spun serves and a powerful forehand. In mixed doubles he always served more gently to the ladies.

The 1985/86 season was saddened by Eric's passing. He was much respected and admired. The Northern Suburbs Club in recognition of Eric's contribution made this award available to the Association.
