

#### **Item 11. General Business**

During the meeting the following was noted:

- 4 player teams would make it easier for smaller Clubs like Lindisfarne to field a team. This is something the Committee are keen to pursue.
- Grading's will need to be bedded down for ladies playing in male dominated divisions. The suggestion of .5 ITN difference for top levels and 1 ITN difference at lower levels.
- Comments to the committee have been received that players currently in a 4 player team would not play in a 6 player team now.
- The committee may need some flexibility in making a division with 6 player teams to accommodate the abundance of players in the same grade.
- Team captains should be educated and reminded to note on score sheets when Clubs are not opened by 7.15pm.
- The newsletter to remind captains that they should not contact opposing team captains on the day of the match for any changes.

Ken Smith mentioned that it would be useful to have the option of using other Club Courts like Lindisfarne when trying to accommodate the larger clubs with many teams where Court availability may present a problem.

Meeting closed 9.03 pm.
