### **Newsletter No 4**



We are now almost half way through the season with Christmas very close. A few weeks break might give any injuries some time to come right in time to finish the season. I hope everyone has a relaxing Christmas and that 2015 offers some enjoyable experiences.

#### **Scoring**

Some confusion still exists about the scoring of matches. Results are based on Rubbers won, then sets won, then games won. Ladders will go on premiership points, rubbers won then percentage.

Points are distributed as follows:

Match win (or rubber)	2 points
Set Win	0 point
Team Win on night (premiership points)	4 points

The maximum points that can be earned on a night is 12 points for all Divisions except X and Y. These divisions have a maximum of 16 points on offer.

Each night there are points awarded for 4 rubbers. To determine a winning team on the night, add the number of rubbers won. If it is 2 rubbers (matches) each, add up the sets won (leave tie-breakers out). If these are even as well, add up the total games won (again leaving out tie-breakers). If these are even, it's a draw. Otherwise, a winner should be determined.

A rubber win is worth 2 points. Once a winner for the night has been determined, another 4 points is awarded. Where rubbers, sets and games are even, a draw is the outcome and both teams will split the points and receive 6 points each for the draw. For a draw in Divisions X and Y, 8 points each will be awarded.

Division X and Y play single set matches, so there are no 3<sup>rd</sup> set tie-breakers to take into account, making scoring slightly less confusing.

## **Entering scores**

It would be appreciated if all captains could enter their team scores in Competition Planner as soon as possible after they've played. This saves division administrators having to chase up results. If you are unable to enter them with a couple of days, please contact your Division Administrator. ## **Score sheets**
