Team formation

Due to a recent conversation between a spectator and an AYC Committee member, I've been asked to add an article to clarify who is responsible for the formation of teams and how they are placed in divisions for the benefit of all players.

In short Clubs are responsible for understanding the strengths of their players, their potential and their grades when forming teams prior to submitting them to the AYC Committee, who are responsible for forming divisions using the teams submitted by Clubs.

Generally speaking, it takes the committee 3 weeks to organise teams into divisions, as we try to make the pennant competitive but fair. Club captains and/or Club representatives work hard to accommodate player requests to play on particular nights or avoid particular nights and play in teams of the same standard and to get the dynamics amenable. If you wish to be in a different team, then you should take this up with your Club.

Clubs suggest a preferred night for teams to play at their home ground. The AYC Committee try to negotiate the least amount of nights that each division will play, once divisions are filled. The AYC committee rely on Clubs to recognise their better players or improving players and place them in appropriate teams for the season.

A reminder that the AYC committee is Club representatives – it is not an independent body.

End of Season Dinner

The End of Season Dinner has been booked for Saturday 2nd May 2015 at The Old Woolstore. Please arrive at 7pm so we can have proceedings underway by 7.30. As previously advised, Clubs will need to collect costs per attendee prior to the dinner. The cost will be \$50 per head for partners and \$30 per head for players. To be eligible for the subsidy, players must have played 6 nights or more during the season.
