Presidents Report

I'll take this opportunity to thank the AYC Committee members who have done a great job again this season representing their Clubs and for the support provided to me especially whilst I skipped the Country a couple of times during the season. Without a Secretary, this role is particularly busy, so the assistance provided to me has been much appreciated.

This season we managed to setup the Pennant from scratch using Competition Planner which allowed us to learn about the system and make become self-sufficient. It's was good to see a few captains entering their own results and playing an active role with the application as well. I congratulate players on moving with these changes and supporting our attempts to improve the pennant experience.

The late request to begin games as close to 7pm as possible worked well due to players being flexible enough to try this giving most players an earlier finish.

Tennis Australia have advised that Competition Planner will get a face lift due in October this year which will make the system more user friendly when it comes to entering scores on mobile devices such as phones and tablets. I have also been advised that the ratings with the new system are to be reviewed and rebuilt with an aim to simplify grading and ensure a single universal rating to give an accurate measure of a player's standard. It will include all competition and tournament results. However, the rebuild to ratings is not due in the October release.

An upgraded set of score sheets were printed late in the season and we expect this will make scoring easier and should make it easier to see an outcome (especially during finals).

The Championships were once again well attended and we thank those who participated and Clubs who hosted these events.

The End of Season Dinner and Awards night was well attended with 100 guests and an enjoyable night was had. Thank you to Ken Smith who once again provided music and entertainment on the night.

It was with sadness, I heard Colin Appleton (a life member of AYC Tennis) passed away a few weeks following the dinner. A tribute to Colin follows this report.

I'd like to thank Lisa McKay for nominating me for the John Drake Award to services to the Association and our sponsors, the Old Woolstore, and Tennis Tasmania for their support again this season.

A sub-committee of Trevor Small and Beth Wisniewski have undertaken a survey of players and non players during the off season to influence changes for next season to increase the number of players participating in the pennant. Hopefully, this will see the Domain enter more teams in upcoming pennants.

Colin Appleton

It was with sadness we heard of the passing of Colin Appleton in May this year.

Colin started playing tennis at 16 years of age and first played AYC in the 1950's. Due to an accident he stopped playing in 1975 and resumed in March 2000.

During the early years he was a member of the AYC committee serving on the executive alongside Ean Cannel who was then President of the Association.

He was well known for always arriving early to matches and looked forward to enjoying supper after the game and acquainting himself with the opposing teams.

One of his highlights of AYC Tennis was winning the 'A' grade men's doubles with Ean Cannel in 1954.

Up until 2011 he was still playing up to 4 times a week and remained passionate about the game and winning.

He was a member of Geilston Bay Tennis Club and is always available in his role as a handyman – a gentle hint and the job is as good as done. He also won the Geilston Bay Tennis Club Person of the Year in 2009.

Colin was made a Life Member of the AYC Tennis Association in 2011.

SPECIAL AWARDS

John Drake

John Drake was, for approximately 25 years the most prominent and active member of the Association. He held the position of Treasurer for all the period and served prominently on all Committees. He was elected a Life Member in 1973. John managed all the Young Liberals (later Liberals) teams, the name which is the only one to have competed in the A.Y.C competition for every year since its conception. Whenever anyone wanted a game John could always accommodate them in one of his teams. His interest in the Association was remarkable; often he would turn up at matches during the week, contributing for many years to "The Mercury" highlighting individual performance in matches. When John retired from playing he gave his racquet to a needy competitor and was known on many occasions to assist players experiencing personal difficulties. Sadly, John passed away in December 1984, this trophy has been presented annually since then to the person seen to be fulfilling John's ideals.

These teams were organised specifically to compete in this Association and went into recess for the off-season. John had suffered from diabetes from childhood, and night tennis was an activity that best suited this condition, unfortunately failing health later forced him to retire from competition but his enthusiasm for management and involvement remained.

SPECIAL AWARDS

Eric Wolfe

For approximately 20 years Eric Wolfe served as the delegate for the Northern Suburbs Club. This was the period when the A.Y.C Tennis Association consisted almost entirely of private social groups. Many players, who were introduced into the A.Y.C competition by Eric, later became prominent members of suburban clubs, which are now the major competitors in this Association. Their subsequent enthusiasm was, no doubt the result of the example set by Eric.

He served for many years on the Match & Tournament and Social Committees and always offered assistance in the management of the Championships, which included numbers in excess of 250.

Eric was renowned for his sportsmanship and gentlemanly court behaviour, with a game characterised by heavily spun serves and a powerful forehand. In mixed doubles he always served more gently to the ladies.

The 1985/86 season was saddened by Eric's passing. He was much respected and admired.

The Northern Suburbs Club in recognition of Eric's contribution made this award available to the Association.
