Commencement Of Play

Achieving a timely outcome has been one of the aims of moving to the four player teams. We have discussed the commencement of play rules at our recent meeting and decided that if it is not possible to start either of the first sets by 7:45 due to players being late the opposing team has the right to impose a forfeit. Should players arrive late the opposition has the discretion as to how much warm up time should be allowed.

Playing Order

A couple of minor problems with ungraded fillins playing in the wrong position. Just a reminder that an ungraded player assumes the grade of the player they replace, this may mean that they assume a different grade each time they play, until a grade has been provided.
