Roster 02

Very encouraging to see the continued increase in numbers, over the last four rosters we have progressed from 29, to 34,38 and now 47 teams. Clearly the decision to move to short rosters and the work the Clubs and Committee have done to progress single night Divisions has resonated with the players. Most Clubs are experiencing an uptake in interest with a mix of both brand new and returning players now participating with those who have stuck at it.

While the roster length was a simple change achieving consistent single nights across a growing pennant that meets the varying needs of the participating Clubs, along with some players now looking to play in two divisions, is somewhat more challenging.
