The Blackberries on the bank at the back of the Club room have been removed. The area is being assessed by the Council to work out the best way to keep them under control.

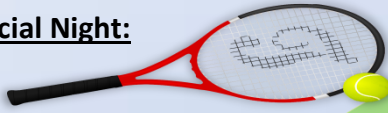
