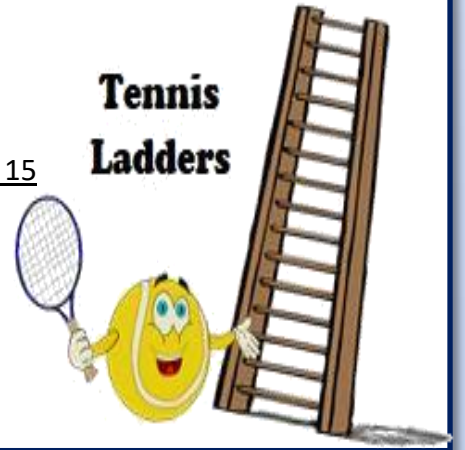

What's happening:

Lights on courts 1 & 2 have been assessed by an engineer and 2 poles needed to be removed for safety reasons. These lights have now been removed and the courts can be used during daylight hours. A LUX lighting assessment also been conducted on the courts to determine if they are still compliant for night tennis competitions. If not they will look at whether upgrading the lumens in the remaining lights will work or temporary lights may be needed to enable us to continue night competitions at home. In the meantime, all night tennis home games will need to be moved to other venues. Also Council has had Geotechnical engineers conduct an assessment of the subsidence of the courts 3 and 4, all these reports will be collated to formulate a way to rectify the issues.



We have set a date for our last Working Bee for 2019, **Sunday 8th December at 10am**. We're hoping to spring clean Club room and courts, as competitions will be drawing to a close for the year.



The Club Room gate lock is to be put through the Council lock and not the latch, as the Council needs access to maintain the blackberries/weeds on bank behind the Club room. Please note: The Blackberries have been sprayed with weed killer. High tensile chain has been installed on all gates around the Club and courts.

New security lights have been installed around the Club room. We are also looking at quotes to fix and strengthen the shed so it can be used again as we have been unable to use it since the last break-in.

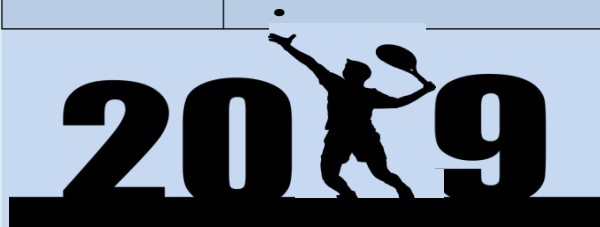
