## President's Report AGM 17 December 2017

#### **COMMITTEE**

Just prior to our 2016 AGM, a special ceremony was conducted wherein Ron Phillips was honoured with life membership of the club. Ron has provided 19 years sterling service as Club Treasurer. Ron has now advised that due to health and family matters he would be stepping down as Treasurer at our 2017 AGM.

Lyn Barker has agreed to become our new Treasurer. At the same time we have split some of the tasks Ron has been undertaking, such as counting, collecting and banking receipts lodged at the club house, and redistributing some payment processes to committee members. The new arrangements have been in place since 1 November 2017.

We wish Ron all the best in his retirement.

We welcomed 2 new members to the committee during the year – Brian Hallett and Maggie Bertogg. Both are contributing to the efficient running of the Club.

#### **COACHING**

Our professional coach Di Peterson has reported that her Junior coaching program involved just over 40 players participating frequently in the red, orange, green and yellow ball programs during the year. She has been really pleased to witness the enthusiasm and commitment of the children to their tennis each week. She can't wait to do it all again in 2018.

Cooroy junior fixtures teams successfully participated in the Winter and Summer NDTA series, with almost all teams making it through to the minor finals, and grand Final, with Division 4 finishing runners up. Due to Uni. and work commitments Glen Millar ceased as our Junior Match Court Supervisor, and we thank Glen for his great work over the past 2 years.

Alex Lloyd is our new Junior Match Court Supervisor, and he has quickly picked up his role. It is great to see young players step up and undertake more responsibility in the running of their game.

We also had 3 to 5 juniors compete in the Sunshine Coast Junior Series, and Di hopes to encourage more players to get involved in 2018.

It is encouraging that quite a few junior players are opting to do semi private hitting, with Bailey Collins and Tyson Pring on a weekly basis. Both boys are high level Sunshine Coast juniors and they really enjoy working with our up and coming players.

Our Ladies Coach and Match session is still going well on Thursday evenings.

#### **FUND RAISING AND FINANCE**

Our surplus from ordinary activities in 2016 was \$1043, and 2017 \$6019. This year the Noosa Council has reimbursed us our water and sewerage costs by \$1315.

Our maintenance costs this year have reduced by \$3008, predominately due to court cleaning in 2016, not required in 2017.

In October 2017 we spent \$990 on the removal of the Yellow Poinciana from the front yard of the club house. This tree has been the source of significant problems in recent years. We have selected a replacement species and, subject to weather conditions, we will prepare the area and plant the replacement tree

Julia Walkden has prepared and submitted an application for a *Get Playing and Spaces* grant, to resurface courts 1 and 2, both of which are showing advanced signs of surface wear and tear. Unfortunately the application was unsuccessful, however we had been advised that since competition for these grants would be fierce, we should also apply for a *Gambling and Community Benefit Fund* grant, which we have done. Successful applicants will be announced in December (which is fast running out)

Further, on 1 December 2017 Julia prepared and submitted a grant application for new toilet amenities, which would include 2 toilets with hand basins, 1 shower, 1 PWD toilet area (with change area and 1 shower), a multi-use parenting/change area with kitchenette and storage. All facilities will be unisex to meet the criteria for getting a 100% grant. Successful applications will be informed in February 2018.

Julia has done a tremendous job in preparing and submitting these applications, as has all those who assisted. The design drawings for the toilet facilities were done by Rob Lloyd, a club member and qualified architect. Our thanks go to all who assisted with these 3 grant proposals.

Let's hope we get some sort of positive result!

#### **SOCIAL TENNIS**

Tuesday and Thursday morning social tennis continues to grow. Recently we have been getting some suggestions we need to provide more courts as some social players don't like to wait for a turn on court.

Thanks once again to all members of our hard working committee. Also to club members who are not committee members but step in and assist with the regular requirements for our social tennis, and for maintenance tasks that need additional assistance.
