## President's Report AGM 16 December 2018

### COMMITTEE

During the year Brian Hallett resigned from the committee due to him relocating from the Cooroy area.

### COACHING AND JUNIOR FIXTURES

Di Peterson continues as our club coach providing coaching services to our junior program and to senior players wishing individual coaching. Di also coordinates our Junior Fixtures program, which in 2018 has continued in a revised format. The competition is through the Sunshine Coast Tennis League conducted by Tennis Queensland.

Our juniors participated in the 2018 winter season and the 2018 summer season which has just ended.

Our court supervisor during 2018 was Tyson Pring and he performed extremely ably. We hope Tyson can continue in 2019, but this will depend on his University requirements.

### TREASURER'S DUTIES

Lyn Barker our new Treasurer and I met with our auditors at the beginning of the year to finalise how we would continue forward with our treasurer and finance requirements. Our auditors have been very helpful, and Lyn has implemented new streamlined procedures that involve Excel spreadsheets instead of MYOB, our previous accounting system. Finance reports to our committee meetings are now provided electronically. The new arrangements have proven to be very effective and have resulted in the financial statements to be presented by Lyn today.

## GENERAL MATTERS

Brian Hallett, who joined our committee in 2017 resigned from the committee during the year. Brian has sold up and headed North. We thank him for his service and wish him well for the future.

This year we have spent time rationalizing our club records. The Committee has agreed that we keep:

- signed hard copies of our annual financial statements and audit reports indefinitely;
- Signed hard copies of committee, Annual and Special General meetings indefinitely.
- Other records to be kept for specific periods to be determined on as required basis. Eg. hard copies of membership forms – 2 years, creditors invoices – 2 years.
- Incorporation records, constitution, leasing records etc – indefinitely.

## REPAIRS AND MAINTENANCE

- Julia Walkden was successful in gaining a grant which has allowed courts 1 and 2 to be totally refurbished. The work was project managed by Tennis Queensland. Great work Julia.
- Termite damage to the stumps holding up the club house was addressed during the year. Hans Bertogg, Maggie's husband had repair work on the timber. Two stumps, we think, may need replacement and this work is scheduled for early 2019.
- Whilst cleaning down the stumps we noticed termites were active along one of the stumps. We treated the area with Termador and arranged a full pest inspection. The report said there is no evidence of any further active termite infestation.
- Hans and Maggie have also replaced the wooden steps to the club house, as the existing steps were showing signs of rot and general deterioration. We thank Hans and Maggie for their great work.

I note that the entrance to the verandah from the stairway will also have to be replaced fairly soon.

- We laid a new 32mm water pipe from the water meter to the rear of the club house and had it connected to the club house plumbing. Water pressure is now, for the first time since I have been with the club, at a good level.
- The kitchen cabinet has been replaced, and
- A new set of double gates have been installed in the fence behind the club house which will allow for better access for maintenance activities.
- Major electrical repairs were carried to our switchboard area, including new residual current devices, earthed lighting cables and replacement of the existing circuit breakers. The main contactor for the court lights is also in need of replacement, and a replacement is due early in the New Year.

## THANKS

Thanks, once again to all members of our hard working committee. Also to club members and friends who step in and assist with regular requirements for our social tennis, and for maintenance requirements. Thanks to our sponsors who provide funding and frequently unpaid work for us. Finally to Alan Kenzler who continues to maintain our grassed areas and surrounds to such a high standard.
