### Format:

- Separate boys and girls team divisions,
- Teams consist of 4 – 6 players and must be accompanied by a teacher/coach from the school.
- Matches will consist of 4 singles and 2 doubles matches.

*Note: Formats may be adjusted at the Tournament Director's discretion if the event is impacted by inclement weather.*

### Eligibility:

- Schools who win their state championship event or School Sport Association competition (in lieu of a state championship being held) are eligible to submit an application for consideration. Wildcard nominations will be considered according to the teams playing standard (Player ratings considered). All awarded Wildcards by the Tournament Director are final.
- Players must be enrolled as students at their school.
