All Men's. Women's and Juniors

Best of Two (2) Tiebreak sets & a Match Tiebreak:

II-1 & II-3 Men's & Women's Div 1 Finals

TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS

Check the <u>tournament website</u> for more information and regulations. Be prepared to fulfill all tournament commitments including being available to play on each day (unless granted permission prior to the entry deadline) and **booking flights no earlier than 7:30pm on the final day**.

CHECK-IN & ORDER OF PLAY

Player's responsibility to check-in at the Tournament Desk 15min before scheduled matches then go to the court assigned upon being notified. The order of play will be released by the Tournament Director via the tournament website and also sent out to all players via email the afternoon prior to each day.

NOTE: ALL match times are approximations only and can vary on many factors including but not limited to weather, length of previous matches, court availability.

OFFICIATING & BALL KIDS

All matches will be officiated by Tennis Australia Officials, any queries or concerns during a match need to be directed to the official on-court or before/after a match with the Tournament Referee. AO Ballkids will also be present to assist with matches on the Saturday & Sunday.

Opening Ceremony will be on Thursday morning and we encourage all players to be present on-court alongside our 2025 Flagbearers and distinguished guests. Sport Australia's Local Sporting Champions program provides financial assistance for coaches, officials and competitors aged 12-18 participating in state, national or international championships.

If successful, applicants will receive \$500 – \$750 towards the cost of attending their championships. We encourage all players and coaches to apply before attending the Australian Tennis Championships to be eligible.

TRANSPORT & PARKING

Players need to make their own travel arrangements to Melbourne. Taxis and Ubers are always available (24 hours) from Tullamarine Airport. Approximate fare from the airport to the venue is \$80, alternatively you can catch the Skybus to Southern Cross Station then catch the #70 Tram down Flinders Street to Melbourne Park.

Free parking is available each day at the National Tennis Centre via Entrance D off Olympic Boulevard, please refer to this map for directions. Melbourne Park have installed a license plate recognition system at the Eastern Plaza car park for a more efficient and seamless experience. The boom gate at Eastern Plaza car park will open on approach and there is no longer the need to take a ticket. Validation of your parking will now occur using your license plate number, please provide this to Tennis World Reception staff prior to returning to your vehicle.

Pease be aware that there might be other large events on over the weekend in the Melbourne Park precinct so plan your travel accordingly (use public transport or Uber where possible).
