Format:

- Time friendly for families
- Utilises modified balls and courts
- Play lets, No AD scoring, Tiebreaker at 3 games all and First to 4 games wins

- Teams of 3 players with each player getting two doubles and one singles each week
- 3 Player Teams means players are always on the court

Opportunities:

Retain more players

Leagues are a great way of retaining players with more than 80% of players continuing to participate for more than two seasons.

Engage parents

Leagues encourage parents to get on court and assist players with scoring, picking up balls and even supervising teams. It is a great way to introduce them to your club and increase volunteerism.

When:

We recommend that an ANZ Tennis Hot Shots League operates two 6-8 week seasons across summer. Two seasons will enable multiple entry points for players.

- Season one to begin at the commencement of Term 4
- Season two to begin at the commencement of Term 1

Funding:

You may be eligible for funding for court development and line marking.
