

JUNIOR AO 2019 ASIA-PACIFIC WILDCARD PLAY-OFF FACT SHEET



Overview	<i>The Australian Open, Grand Slam of Asia-Pacific, is one of the largest and most prestigious sporting events in the world. Book your place to be in Melbourne in January 2019 with the Junior Australian Open Asia-Pacific Wildcard Play-off (JAWP) taking place in Zhuhai, China. Main Draw Wildcards are on offer for Asia-Pacific's winning Junior Singles tennis players.</i>		
Eligibility	The JAWP is open to all Nationals from the Asia Pacific region, aged 18 and Under as per the ITF rule book definition (born on or after 1st January 2001 and 19th January 2006), excluding Australians, with a ITF Junior World Ranking of 101+ for Boys and 101+ for Girls (based on the expected Junior AO cut-off for Boys of 100 and Girls of 100) at the time of the entry closing. Players with a World Ranking of 1-100 for Boys and 1-100 for Girls may also apply for entry if they are concerned about any points they need to defend. They will need to contact the Tournament Referee for a special exemption to play. Players may also enter AWP Doubles if they fulfill the ATP/WTA ranking points criteria for the AWP Doubles event. <i>To be eligible to participate in JAWP players must have at least one ITF / ATP / WTA Tour ranking point in singles or doubles.</i>

Macau International Airport (MFM) is located 10 km to the venue and hotel, with a border to be crossed. Hong Kong International Airport (HKG) has a ferry to Zhuhai Jiuzhou Port (approximately 45 minutes by cab to the venue and hotel). The ferry is approximately \$260 HKD / 210 RMB (\$33 USD) and taxi fare from port to venue and hotel is approximately 65-75 RMB (\$9-11 USD).
