VISA INFORMATION

All children of players attending **Australian Open 2022** need to apply for an Australian visa.

Below are the three visa types for entry into Australia for AO22 as agreed between Tennis Australia and the Department of Home Affairs.

Please read through the below information to ensure that you apply for the appropriate visa type according to the passport that you will be travelling on. Anyone found to be holding an incorrect visa might be refused entry to Australia or have their visa cancelled.
