Wimbledon 2025 Experience	The Auction will consist of one item for sale, which is the Wimbledon 2025  Experience, as follows:  Wimbledon 2025 Tickets donated by the Wimbledon Foundation:  Two Centre Court Tickets (Tuesday, 1 July 2025,)  Two Ground Passes (Wednesday, 2 July 2025,)  Back of house tour at Wimbledon 2025 (subject to security restrictions)  Flight voucher for Emirates for AUD10,000  Airport transfers (Official AO team vehicle)  7 nights' accommodation at a Wimbledon Partner Hotel (or Hotel Voucher)  Signed Poster from Wimbledon 2024  Invitation to an Aussie BBQ, hosted at the Tennis Australia House in Wimbledon in 2025  Gift bag with a retail value of AUD1,000
Reserve	This Auction is subject to a reserve price as determined by ATF prior to the auction.
Estimated Value	The Package is a money can't buy experience.
Payment	The successful bidder must pay the ATF within 28 days after the close of the Auction. On payment, the ATF will issue a receipt and further details of the Wimbledon Experience but will not provide a tax-deductible receipt (as it is not a donation).
Purpose of Funds Raised	All proceeds of the Auction will go toward the ATF for the purpose of supporting activities and programs for five- to 24-year-olds who face adversity.

# **Terms and conditions**

1. Entry into the Auction (including the placing of any bid) is deemed acceptance of these terms.

# **Conduct of the Auction**

- 2. The auctioneer has full discretion over the conduct of the Auction including:
  - (a) determining the amounts by which the bidding is to be advanced;
  - (b) refusing to accept any bid for any reason; and
  - (c) withdrawing the Wimbledon Experience from sale at any time prior to Completion.
- 3. The sale by auction is complete when the auctioneer announces its completion by the fall of the hammer or in other customary manner (**Completion**). Until such an announcement is made, any bidder may retract their bid.

# Successful bidder

4. The Wimbledon Experience will be sold to the person who bids the highest price at Completion, unless it fails to meet the reserve set by the ATF (**successful bidder**).



- 5. The successful bidder (and their companion/s if applicable) will:
  - (a) be responsible for meeting all the entry requirements to the event and relevant country (including passports, visas, vaccinations and immunisations);
  - (b) booking suitable flights and transport to attend the relevant event; and
  - (c) comply with any terms and conditions of the relevant transport carrier, accommodation provider, service provider, insurance provider and in particular any health, behaviour, age and safety requirements.

If the successful bidder does not meet these requirements, they may incur additional costs or forfeit all or part of the Wimbledon Experience.

# **The Wimbledon Experience**

- 6. The Wimbledon Experience (in part or full):
  - (a) is subject to the Wimbledon Foundation's terms and conditions in section 7, below;
  - (b) is not transferable, exchangeable or redeemable for cash;
  - (c) is not refundable if the successful bidder does not take the benefit of it;
  - (d) may be substituted with a suitable alternative, if the ATF is unable to provide any part of it (for reasons that are not the fault of the successful bidder);
  - (e) does not include any associated costs specifically included in the Schedule (for example, transport costs, meals, taxes, spending money, in-room charges, insurance, etc);
  - (f) contains flight vouchers and event tickets which are subject to the relevant terms and conditions, and are not replaceable if they are lost, stolen, damaged or expire;

# **Wimbledon Foundation Terms and Conditions**

- 7. The Wimbledon Foundation has the following terms which apply to the Wimbledon Experience:
  - (a) Names and email addresses of the individual users of the tickets must be given by the Australian Tennis Foundation in writing to the Wimbledon Foundation no later than Thursday 19 June 2025. The successful bidder must provide relevant information to the ATF to meet this deadline..
  - (b) Tickets are issued subject at all times to the AELTC's Ticket Terms and Conditions and Conditions of Entry. In particular, ticket holders obtaining a ticket pursuant to an auction conducted by the Australian Tennis Foundation are strictly prohibited from advertising, selling, offering for sale, offering at auction, promoting or offering as a prize in any contest, competition, game of chance, lottery or sweepstake, donating or otherwise transferring such tickets.
  - (c) Tickets will be issued digitally via the Wimbledon app. Ticket holders will be required to sign up for a myWimbledon account and install the Wimbledon app on their mobile devices to receive tickets.
  - (d) Tickets cannot be transferred to a different date or year and must be used in the year that they are allocated.
  - (e) Tickets allocated are at the discretion of the Wimbledon Foundation and cannot be exchanged.
  - (f) Ticket holders must make their own travel and accommodation arrangements for travelling to and attending The Championships. Information can be found online with the Ticket Holder's Handbook at Planning Your Day which may be subject to updates from time to time.



- (g) Tickets do not include any access to private hospitality or Debenture areas, and no food or drink expenses are included in this offer.
- (h) Any personal information relating to the issue and use of tickets will be processed in accordance with AELTC's Privacy Policy.

# **Dispute resolution**

- 8. If any person has any issues in connection with this Auction, it may submit a notice of dispute by email to <a href="mailto:ATF@tennis.com.au">ATF@tennis.com.au</a>. The complainant and the ATF will endeavour to first settle the dispute by discussions between them.
- 9. If the dispute is not resolved within 14 days (or such other period as agreed in writing by the parties) after the written notice of the dispute has been given by the complainant, the parties may refer the dispute to mediation to be administered by the Australian Dispute Centre (ADC).
- 10. If the dispute has not been settled within 28 days of the appointment of a mediator, the parties may then take further action to enforce their rights.

#### General

- 11. To the extent permitted by law, the ATF:
  - (a) takes no responsibility for the loss of prize/s due to incorrect or imprecise delivery or contact details provided by the successful bidder; and
  - (b) makes no representations or warranties as to the quality, suitability or merchantability of any of the goods or services offered as part of the Wimbledon Experience as they relate to the successful bidder.
- 12. Failure by the ATF to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights. The ATF reserves its legal rights to recover damages or other compensation.
