New tennis opportunities for players with Autism

These opportunities include eligibility to:

- Play in the Australian Tennis Championships being hosted at the Australian Open in January
- Compete at the Players with an intellectual impairment (PWII) State Championships
- Participating in local PWII Tournaments
- International representative competitions for high-functioning Autism are currently being developed by INAS

In addition to these Tennis Australia opportunities, Special Olympics also run national and international events for those with high-functioning Autism.
