



New tennis opportunities for players with Down Syndrome

These opportunities include eligibility to:

- ▶ Represent Australia at the 2019 INAS Global Games in Brisbane
- ▶ Play in the Australian Tennis Championships being hosted in Melbourne in January
- ▶ Compete at the Players with an intellectual impairment (PWII) State Championships
- ▶ Participating in local PWII Tournaments

In addition to these Tennis Australia opportunities, Special Olympics and INAS also run national and international events for those with Down Syndrome.
