Formats:

<u>HotShots</u>: Children are introduced to competition tennis by being part of a HotShots team. Three children per team play for about 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ hours on Sunday mornings through the second term of school. The dates are likely to be from 6th May for about 8 weeks.

<u>Juniors</u>: <u>Singles/Doubles Rubbers</u> (2 to 4 players) best-of-2 sets singles and doubles OR <u>Triples</u> (3 players in team and each plays a singles 6 game set and two doubles/mixed 6 game sets).

<u>Seniors</u>: <u>Singles/Doubles</u> <u>Rubbers</u> (2 to 4 players best-of-3 sets singles and best-of-2 sets doubles) OR <u>Mens/Mixed Rubbers</u> (4 players in team and each plays a singles best-of-2 sets and two doubles/mixed best-of-2 sets).

<u>Pennant</u>: Women or Men (4 in a team playing a singles best-of-3 one week and two doubles best-of-3 the other week).
