Fencing

The City of Casey is funding new fencing around courts 1 to 6. The fencing will be black with a low "viewing" fence along the side of courts 1 and 3.

Work is expected to start early October and take about two weeks to complete.

Doveton Junior Tournament

Younger pupils from the coaching squads will compete in Green Ball and Yellow Ball matches. The tournament will be a warm up for the start of the summer season and to introduce new players to the club, including players from the scholarship program playing their first season of competition.

Summer Teams

The TCAV Age Championships will use Doveton courts during school holidays from Thursday 4th to Sunday 7th Oct.

The tournament has been running for 50 or so years for players in 16&U, 14&U, 12&U and 10&U age categories. The main venue is MCC/Glen Iris and, as well as Doveton, other matches will be at Dingley, Dendy Park and Whites Lane/Mulgrave.

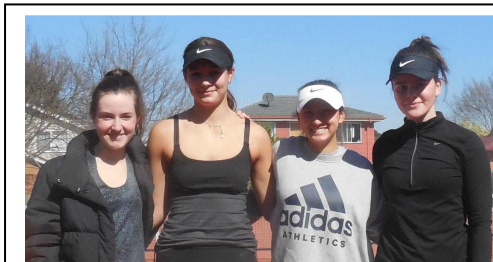
