**Our Club Redevelopment:** We have now had very supportive meetings with Glen Eira College, Tennis Victoria, the new Caulfield Racecourse Reserve Trust and Glen Eira Council senior officers whose help we need to make our project work. We are planning for the first stage of our redevelopment to be in the second half of 2019 - resurface our courts with artificial grass, plus new fencing and automated entry and lights. Over the next three months we will get further technical advice on lighting and drainage, followed by final quotes and drawings. We will then apply in May for a grant from the Victorian Government's Community Sports Facilities annual grant program and seek a contribution from the Council for the new fencing, drainage and vegetation works.

The second and third stages of redevelopment are years away, but include two new multi-purpose sports courts west of our courts and a modern joint new clubhouse.

<u>Coaching Club Members</u>: We require people coached at our courts to be a Club Member in one of three ways:

- Join as new Club members and receive a fee discount of 20%; or
- Be a Coaching Court Member for a fee of \$20 per year a person receiving accredited coaching (and any member of their family) may be registered as a Coaching Court Member and play on the courts (if available) during the hour before or after the coaching lesson; or
- Otherwise be registered as a Coaching Affiliate Member without fee so our Club can communicate about Club activities.
