



Court Policy

- All competition tennis takes priority over social tennis*
- The Club Coach has courts allocated which take priority over social tennis
- Organised practice/training i.e. Junior team practice takes priority over social tennis
- All members and non-members wanting to use the courts for social tennis must book a court via the online court booking system
- All members/non-members with a court booking receipt will take priority over members/non-members who did not book a court and they will be asked to vacate the court
- Court hire under lights is available to be purchased via the online court booking system
- The Green Gully Tennis Club reserves the right to override any member/non-member court booking if an appropriate need arises. E.g. Courts allocated to coaching (plexi-cushion) are washed out due to weather but mod grass are fit for play. The coach has the right to override a court booking and use the mod grass court as per Number 2 above.

*Social Tennis is defined as any court usage outside of permanent bookings. Permanent bookings include competition, coaching and training

There is a live court calendar available online and can be accessed via your computer, smart phone or tablet 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. This calendar will show you when the courts are being used and when they are free for social tennis bookings
