TOURNAMENT RULES & POLICIES

Age Eligibility

All entrants must supply their birth dates on the entry form and supply their Birth Certificate if requested. Eligibility is based on a player's age as at the last day of the month in which the tournament finishes.

Withdrawals

Any player may withdraw their entry prior to the draw being completed minus the administration fee. Withdrawals after the draw has been completed will not be eligible for a refund, trophies or placings in that event, whatever round they reached, unless the Committee should decide otherwise.

Matches

The continuous play format will be used for all events with sufficient entries. For smaller events, round robins will be used. Formats will vary at each JDS.

TQ membership

All players must be registered with Tennis Queensland prior to participating.

This tournament is sanctioned by Tennis Queensland and will be conducted in accordance with the laws of the game adopted by Tennis Australia. You acknowledge that as a participant in this tournament you are required to comply with various rules and policies. By lodging an entry into this tournament, you agree to comply with and confirm that you understand:

- * Tennis Queensland Extreme Heat Policy



ORANGE HOT SHOTS

Orange Hot Shots is played on a 3/4 size court and the ball used is a low compression orange ball which is around 50% slower than a normal ball. The players score using the 1,2,3 then 4 point system.

GREEN HOT SHOTS

Green Hot Shots is played on a full size court with a green low compression ball. This ball is around 25% slower than a normal ball. The scoring is 15, 30, 40 and game. The rules of a regular tennis match applies.
