

## NORTH EASTERN JUNIOR TENNIS ASSOCIATION Inc.

- 1. A player cannot undertake the role of Team Manager.
- 2. Know the NEJTA Match Rules and apply them with the players in your team.
- 3. Your position is in an advisory and encouragement capacity only.
- 4. Take action if requested to do so by the Home Supervisor.
- 5. Team Managers and spectators are only permitted on court between sets to assist the players in preparing the court for play.
- 6. Refer all disputes including Match Rules, Code of Conduct and Dress Code issues to the Home Supervisor immediately.
- 7. A Team Manager must be present for the duration of match. This includes both home and away matches.
- 8. Keep a record of weekly results including players names (both the home team and the visiting team) and scores.
- 9. Check details on trols by Wednesday following the match to ensure all details have been entered correctly. Notify your junior secretary if incorrect.
- 10. If a match has been washed out and attendance is not required, ensure players names are entered into trols in the correct order by 6.30pm Monday following the match.
