Positioning
*If a player is on the same amount points as another, then the player that has received the highest points in 1 event e.g. player 1 has won 35 points from the French Open and that is their highest score for all events compared to player 2 where their highest is 20 points means that player 1 will be positioned above player 2 on the ladder.
*If player 1 has the same highest point score as player 2 but has more of them e.g. player 1 has 2 lots of 20 points from the events and player 2 has 1 lot of 20 points then player 1 will be positioned higher on the ladder.
*If the players have the same point results then they are tied in the same position on the ladder.
