

2017 Sydney Badge FAQs:

What matches Start at 11:30am?

Any first round match of the day played on NATURAL Grass will commence at 11:30am and will conclude at 2:15pm
The second round match will commence at 2:20pm and will conclude at 5:05pm.

What matches Start at 12:00pm?

Any first round match of the day played on any surface OTHER THAN NATURAL GRASS will commence at 12:00pm The second round match will commence at 2:50pm and will conclude at 5:35pm.

The Venue I'm competing at has lights, will they be used?

Yes, if a venue has lights they will be used up until and no later than 5:35pm.

If I don't like Wilson tennis Balls do I still have to use them for Badge Matches?

Yes, it is a requirement that all matches within the Sydney Badge Competition use Wilson tennis balls as was the case with Head in previous years. Contact Robert Howe for prices and a ordering form.

Will there be a Challenge Meeting in 2017?

The 2017 Sydney Badge league will not have a Challenge Meeting. In place of the Challenge Meeting there will be an appeal process. The complete steps of the appeal process are located in the 2017 Autumn Sydney Badge Rules.

What Ratings will be used to rate the Autumn Badge Teams?

A ratings process will occur for the 2017 Autumn Comp, which will be similar to previous years as we transition to utilizing the new National Ratings for Competitions and Leagues.

How many players can be entered in a team?

Teams are to consist of a maximum of 10 players. Registered teams must consist of at least 5 members.

When should we start entering teams?

You can start entering teams as soon as you have a complete team. Clubs no longer need to do a bulk upload of teams. Each team is now individually entered through the online entry. The sooner you put your team in the sooner the club can enter you online.
