

2020 Sydney Badge FAQs:

What matches Start at 11:30am?

Any first round match of the day played on NATURAL Grass will commence at 11:30am and will conclude at 2:15pm The second round match will commence at 2:20pm and will conclude at 5:05pm.

What matches Start at 12:00pm?

Any first round match of the day played on any surface OTHER THAN NATURAL GRASS will commence at 12:00pm The second round match will commence at 2:50pm and will conclude at 5:35pm.

The Venue I'm competing at has lights, will they be used?

Yes, if a venue has lights they will be used up until and no later than 5:35pm.

Will there be a Challenge Meeting in 2020?

No, the Sydney Badge league will not have a Challenge Meeting. In place of the Challenge Meeting there will be an appeal process. The complete steps of the appeal process are located in the 2020 Sydney Badge Rules.

What Ratings will be used to rate the Sydney Badge Teams?

A ratings process will occur for the 2020 Badge Comp, which will be similar to previous years. The Tennis Australia National Ratings will be used for the Sydney Badge Competition.

How many players can be entered in a team?

Teams are to consist of a maximum of 8 players. Registered teams must consist of at least 5 members.

Can I enter more than 8 players?

Only 5-8 base players may be entered per team. Any additional players will need to be added as reserves.

When should we start entering teams?

You can start entering teams as soon as you have a complete team. Teams will be entered through your badge delegate via the League Manager System.

How do I pay team entry?

All teams will be directly invoiced in the first week of the badge competition via their badge delegate.
