### PREMIER LEAGUE

#### Premier League Competition:

Premier League will be returning in 2020 as a stand-alone event and separate from the Sydney Badge Competition.

- Playing Dates will be from: Sat 15th August - Sat 19th September.
- Match formats will include Singles and Doubles Matches.

#### Team Entries:

Team Entries will be for 2020 Badge Competition will be entered by your Club/Association's Badge Delegate through League Manager.

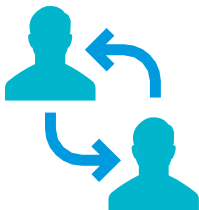
Teams will enter a minimum of five (5) and maximum of eight (8) base players. Additional players can be added as reserves.

Team Entry = \$250 per team. Clubs will be invoiced after Round One.



#### Communication:

Each Club/ Association will identify a contact person or 'Badge Delegate' to assist in communication between their Club/ Association and Tennis NSW Competitions Team.



#### Reserve Players:

Player can be used providing their National Player Rating (TA Rating) is equal to/ weaker than the player they are replacing.

Reserve players will be entered by team captains into Match Centre.



#### Finals Eligibility:

Base players are eligible to participate in Semi-Finals/ Finals providing they have played a minimum of three (3) matches.
