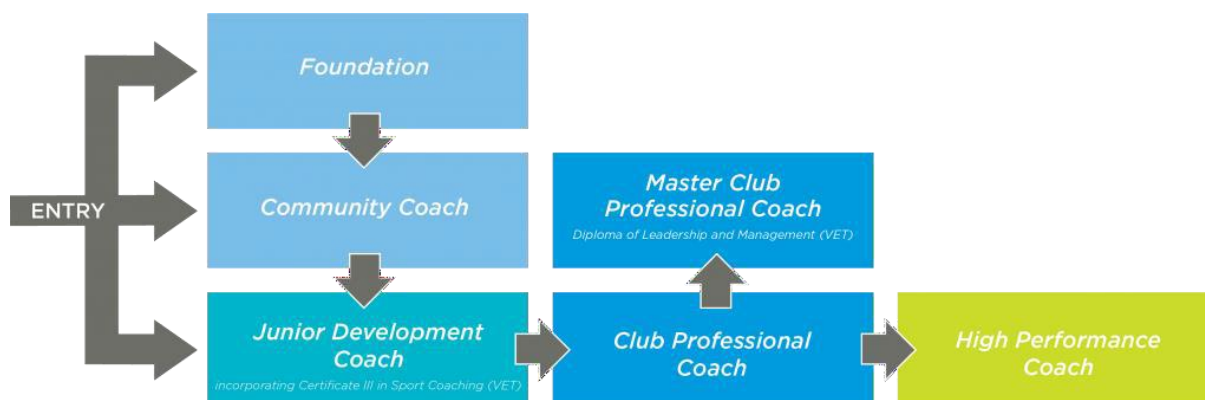

FAQ's



Q. Where do I find information on Tennis Australia coaching courses / workshops in NSW?

Q. I am ready to apply for a Tennis Australia coaching course, what documents do I need?

A. The following documents MUST be uploaded during the application

1. NSW Working with Children Check (18 years and over) available here: <https://www.service.nsw.gov.au/transaction/apply-working-children-check>
2. National Police Check* (16 years and over) available here: <https://www.nationalcrimecheck.com.au/>

**Please note that if it is your first time submitting a National Police Check to Tennis Australia, it must be dated within 3 months of submission in order to be accepted.*

Q. Do I have to wait for my WWCC and NPC to apply for TA coaching courses?

A. Yes. You need to upload current documents to be considered for all courses

Q. How do I know which course is suitable for me and what is the cost?

A. All course information can be found here, just click on the course you are interested in: <https://www.tennis.com.au/coaches/coach-education>

Q. Do I need a certain level of playing experience to apply for a course?

A. Playing experience is considered yet not essential

Q. The registration for the course has closed, can I still register for the course?

A. No. If you have missed the closing date, you can no longer apply for the course.

Q. I need a supervising coach, what should I do?

A. You can engage with your local Tennis Australia current Club Pro coach member. Alternatively, you can visit tennis.com.au and search for local coaches in your area or contact the Coach Development team for more information.

Q. Do I receive coach membership / insurance?

A. Yes, you receive complimentary Tennis Australia coach membership until the end of the membership period.

Q. What can I expect to be coaching once I have completed each course?

A. Foundation Coaching Course – Assist in conducting safe Blue and Red Stage ANZ Tennis HS activities under the direct supervision of a qualified tennis coach

Community Coaching Course - These coaches are responsible for delivering ANZ Tennis Hot Shots sessions for players aged 4-12 years under the guidance of a Head coach

Junior Development - These coaches are responsible for planning and delivering ANZ Tennis Hot Shots sessions and programs for players aged 4-14 years.

Club Pro - These coaches are managing a small business, providing a range of coaching programs and services, managing and training staff, liaising with club volunteers and/or local council. Club Professional coaches may also be coaching talented regional and state level players.

Q. I currently live outside Australia, can I apply for Tennis Australia coaching courses?

A. You must have the right to work in Australia to be able to apply for a course and receive the above documents. For a Junior Development Course you need to be in the country / same state for a minimum of 6 months. For a Club Professional Course you need to be in the country / same state for a minimum of 9 months. Tennis Australia does not assist with Visa applications.
