# ABOUT THE FUND

At the inaugural ATP Cup in January 2020, Tennis NSW and the NSW Government were pleased to announce the launch of the NSW ATP Cup Tennis Legacy Fund, which will invest more than \$5 million into community tennis over three years.

The spirit, energy and success of the ATP Cup is encouraging many to pick up a racquet and the Legacy Fund will play a key role in continuing to ensure the growth of tennis participation.

The Fund will target infrastructure, facility development and participation programs that will support the growth of the game across the State for many generations to come:



## FOR MAJOR INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT

FOR SIGNIFICANT INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS TO DEVELOP NEW OR UPGRADED KEY HUBS WITH STRATEGIC ALIGNMENT TO INVESTMENT PRIORITIES FOR TENNIS, WITH THE TOTAL FUNDING OF MORE THAN \$4M AVAILABLE OVER THREE YEARS.



## FOR FACILITY DEVELOPMENT OR UPGRADE

FOR SMALL TO MEDIUM FACILITY DEVELOPMENT OR UPGRADE PROJECTS THAT WILL INCREASE PARTICIPATION, WITH \$600,000 OVER THREE YEARS.



## FOR PARTICIPATION INITIATIVES

FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF TARGETED PROGRAMS ALIGNED TO PARTICIPATION GROWTH, WITH \$300,000 AVAILABLE OVER THREE YEARS



## FOR FURTHER PARTICIPATION INITIATIVES

FOR THE EXPANSION OF OR NEW TENNIS NSW MANAGED PROGRAMS ALIGNED TO PARTICIPATION GROWTH. THIS CATEGORY IS NOT OPEN TO APPLICATIONS. \$300,000 IS AVAILABLE FOR SPECIFIC PARTICIPATION INITIATIVES DETERMINED BY TENNIS NSW AND NSW GOVERNMENT.

The Fund will provide assistance to Tennis NSW affiliated Clubs, Associations and local Councils across NSW.

Further leveraging of the Fund with key strategic partners will result in the most significant investment into our sport, at grassroots level, in living memory.

Projects that receive funding from another NSW Government agency / program are ineligible for Categories 2 and 3.

# GRANT AND PROJECT READINESS

Obtaining funding through the NSW ATP Cup Tennis Legacy Fund will be a competitive process. Applicants should:

## PREPARE

- Prepare your project well in advance of grant funding programs being announced and open
- Tap into resources to plan a successful project such as those provided by Tennis, NSW Office of Sport, local Council and other sources
- Determine contributions and secure supporting funding

## PARTNER

- Work in partnership e.g. Councils, Clubs and Associations, schools, other landowners, local business partnerships and community partnerships
- Obtain landowner consent for works, plan resources to execute a project, seek support on funding applications and direct funding contributions

## PLAN

- Develop realistic plans, understand the case for action/change, obtain quotes, approvals and commitments to ensure you have a project that is deliverable and justified
- Successful projects can take time to prepare and be realised. Be grant ready when new grant funding opportunities arise
