Keirle Park Tennis Centre is a thriving six court venue located on Sydney's Northern Beaches that welcomes over 1,300 participants each week. Keirle Park Tennis Centre attracts players of all ages and abilities to participate in social play, coaching programs and competitions. Luke Penning and Rochelle Sangsta operate the centre on behalf of Tennis Northern Beaches and employ eight full-time staff. The opportunity to increase participation and community engagement through events and school competitions was identified after completing a Venue Sustainability Rating audit and Classroom to Club action plan. Luke saw great potential to connect with local primary schools to host their first ever Todd Woodbridge Cup competition.















TOURNAMENTS & COMPETITIONS SUCCESS STORY

The Todd Woodbridge Cup is a school Teams Tennis Competition for students in Years 3 and 4. The event provides participants with an opportunity to represent their school with their peers, while encouraging participation, teamwork whilst providing a positive experience playing tennis.

Luke and Rochelle realised the potential opportunities of hosting a Todd Woodbridge Cup in collaboration with Tennis NSW, including:

- Engaging and forming positive and ongoing relationships with local schools
- Providing children an opportunity to experience their first red ball competition

- Delivering free sessions in participating schools prior to the event. This facilitated a smooth delivery on the day with the students knowing the rules, structure and coaches
- Demonstrating best practice by sending schools a risk assessment and COVID-19 Safety Plan prior to the event
- Engaging support from local businesses and sponsors, including Wilson
- Opportunity to showcase the range of programming available at Keirle Park Tennis Centre to the local community

These initiatives, along with clear event planning and proactive communication to schools and the wider community, all assisted in the successful event delivery.
