Sydney Junior Team Tennis is an inter-club tennis league in Metropolitan Sydney. With eleven associations, TNSW aims to provide a coordinated approach to team tennis competitions and establishing greater representative opportunities for players and clubs.

SJTT has 4 terms of competition (8 playing weeks). With Metro Sydney Matchplay Series to be offered during school holidays. The dates for 2022 are outlined on page 4. Formats for SJTT are flexible pending on court availability, we recommend running 2x singles matches and 1x doubles match per division.

Term 1	6 th February	3 rd April
Term 2	1 st May	26 th June (No Play 13 th June QBD)
Term 3	24 th July	18 th September
Term 4	16 th October	27 th November

NOTE: Please be advised that this is subject to change - we are happy to accommodate a different time and date given that all clubs in your association have been provided with the same information.

We recommend closing dates are at least 10 days before round 1.

COMPETITION DETAILS

TEAMS CONSIST OF 3 PLAYERS PER TEAM

- Each player will play 1 singles match and 2 doubles matches per round.
- Draw to consist of seven rounds, plus Finals Round (8 weeks).
- Matches played 'Home & Away'.
- Match results count towards Player UTR.
- Teams will be mixed gender for all competitions.

COMPETITION FORMATS

- Singles matches played best of 2 tiebreak sets + match tiebreak. (No-Ad scoring for ALL matches).
- Doubles matches played best of 1 tiebreak set, tiebreak at 6-6. (No-Ad scoring for ALL matches).
- 6 Teams per division (8 week competition) = 7 rounds + Final.

COVID-19 TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

Until further notice, only fully vaccinated individuals, persons under the age of 16 and individuals with a medical exemption are eligible to participate in events and leagues. Persons under 16 will not be required to be vaccinated, however, a fully vaccinated adult who resides in the same household as the child or a guardian who is fully vaccinated and an adult in their household is fully vaccinated must be always in attendance with them. All events and leagues will be required to check the vaccination status of all persons who attend the vaccination. This decision has been made with the best interests of our officials, clubs and volunteers who work tirelessly to support and deliver tennis throughout NSW and ensure we are providing a safe environment for all tennis events.

ENTRIES CLOSE FRIDAY 28 JANUARY

The format for SJTT is completely flexible to work with each member associations court availability.

Associations are able to modify:

- Team size
- Court number based on availability
- Days & times
- Playing format (i.e. singles and doubles sets)
- Player level

NOTE: the level of each division will also vary across associations and will only be confirmed after all entries have been received.

Below is an example:

- 3 player teams – (player 3 is reserve)
- 1 court available
- One 6 game singles set
- One 6 game doubles set

Sydney Matchplay Series

The Sydney Matchplay Series is an inter-association event played during the school holidays. Aimed at the introductory level of play (UTR 0-3), it provides players and opportunity to play multiple matches in the round robin/compass draw formats. The series is played across 3 venues, which split by age group, in the designated association for that event. Each school holidays will have a different association hold the event.

Inter-District

Players who compete in SJTT may be eligible to compete in Inter-District.

The SJTT will be an opportunity for the association to pick the top players to represent the association in the Inter-District competition. Inter-District takes place in Term 3.

Inter-District is one of the oldest tennis competitions in Australia, with the first competition in 1921. Initially only the 17 Metropolitan Associations participated in the competition. Over the years the competition has expanded to include near Country Associations. The age groups for this competition are Seniors, Juniors and Blackwell & Angus & Coote Cups.
