Role Title: Deputy Chair, Tennis NSW Regional Committee

Position Type: Volunteer

About the Regional Committee

Tennis NSW operates six Regional Committees—Southeast, Southwest, Central West, Northumberland, Northeast, and Northwest—each playing a vital role in representing the interests of their respective regions. These committees are empowered through delegations determined by NSW Tennis Country and the Board of Tennis NSW, as outlined in the **Regional Committee Charter**.

Role Overview

The Deputy Chair of a Tennis NSW Regional Committee plays a pivotal role in supporting the Regional Committee Chair and ensuring the effective operation and governance of the committee. This role acts as the Chair's deputy, stepping into their responsibilities as required, and contributes to fostering a vibrant tennis ecosystem by encouraging competitive participation and supporting player development at the regional level. This leadership position requires a strong commitment to good governance, strategic collaboration, and fostering a positive culture among committee members and stakeholders.

Key Responsibilities

Support to the Chair:

- Assist the Regional Committee Chair in fulfilling their duties and responsibilities.
- Serve as the acting Chair in the Chair's absence, ensuring the seamless functioning of the committee.

Committee Guidance and Oversight:

- Provide guidance and mentorship to other Regional Committee members to enhance their contributions while overseeing and promoting good governance practices within the Regional Committee.

Regional Tennis Development:

- Assist in growing participation in regional competitive play by developing and promoting innovative initiatives while collaborating with stakeholders to support and enhance regional player development pathways.
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Application Process

This position is appointed by resolution of the NSW Tennis Country Management Committee. Interested candidates should provide a brief expression of interest outlining their relevant skills, experience, and commitment to the growth of tennis in their region.

Time Commitment

This is a volunteer position that requires approximately 3 hours per week along with attendance at online committee meetings (4-5 per year), and occasional regional engagements.

Remuneration

This is a volunteer position. Out of pocket expenses are reimbursed as approved.
