



## Role Description

**Role Title:** Regional Representative Player Selector.

**Position Type:** Volunteer

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## About the Regional Committee

Tennis NSW operates six Regional Committees—Southeast, Southwest, Central West, Northumberland, Northeast, and Northwest—each playing a vital role in representing the interests of their respective regions. These committees are empowered through delegations determined by NSW Tennis Country and the Board of Tennis NSW, as outlined in the **Regional Committee Charter**.

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## Role Overview

The Regional Representative Player Selector is responsible for the selections of all regional representative players within their respective region. This role leads the oversight of the selections on behalf of the relevant Regional Committee, develops new selection criteria aligned with current policies, and communicates with players and parents regarding selections. The role may also require attending regional development sessions to observe players and liaise with coaches on players development.

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## Key Responsibilities:

### Player Evaluation:

- Attend and observe regional training sessions, matches, and tryouts to assess players skills, physical abilities, and potential for growth.
- Develop criteria to evaluate players performance across various aspects of the sport.
- Collaborate with other selectors and coaches to ensure an objective and thorough assessment process.

### Selection Process:

- Assist in identifying top-performing athletes for regional representative teams.
- Support the selection of players for specific age groups, levels, or special events.
- Ensure the fair and transparent selection of athletes.

### Communication and Feedback:

- Communicate with players, parents, and coaches regarding selection outcomes, offering constructive feedback and guidance where appropriate.
  - Ensure that all players are kept informed of the selection process, criteria, and timeline.
  - Respond to player and parent inquiries with professionalism and clarity.
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## Application Process

This position is appointed by resolution of the NSW Tennis Country Management Committee. Interested candidates should provide a brief expression of interest outlining their relevant skills, experience, and commitment to the growth of tennis in their region.

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## Time Commitment

Approximately 2 hours per week along with attendance at online committee meetings (4-5 per year), and at regional events in line with the requirements to oversee selection.

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## Remuneration

This is a volunteer position. Out of pocket expenses are reimbursed as approved.

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
