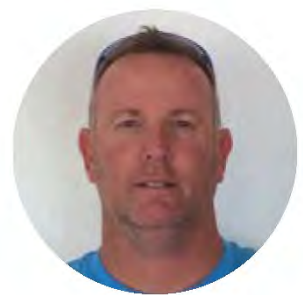

# TEAM FORMATS

- 1. A team should be made up of a maximum of 3 boys and 3 girls or a minimum of 2 boys and 2 girls.*
- 2. Players must play singles, doubles, and mixed in order of ability.*
- 3. Players cannot change their order unless permission is obtained from the event director and regional manager of the team wanting to change.*
- 4. Each match consists of 8 rubbers; it is strongly recommended that the following order of play for each match is followed*
  - 2 mixed doubles*
  - 1 boys doubles*
  - 1 girls doubles*
  - 2 boys singles*
  - 2 girls singles*
- 5. POOL ROUNDS AND PLAYOFFS IN ALL AGE GROUPS WILL BE THE BEST OF 2 SHORT SETS (7-POINT TIEBREAK AT 3 ALL) PLUS A 10-POINT MATCH TIEBREAK IF REQUIRED.**
- 6. ALL TEAM EVENT MATCHES WILL BE PLAYED USING NO-AD SCORING (RECEIVERS' CHOICE)**
- 7. Matches must be completed before the next round starts on allocated courts. Matches may start earlier if courts are available.*
- 8. On-court coaching will be allowed once per rubber by the nominated team manager.*



# MATCH FORMATS

The following formats will be used throughout the team event competition. Team managers need to ensure that all player's play the same number of matches throughout the week.

Event directors will announce the match formats before the qualifying and each match.

# SCORING



- 1. The Regional Shield is presented to the team with the best average finish position across all age groups at the completion of the event (with a minimum of 4 teams).*
  - 2. If at the end of the week, two teams are tied for first place, head to head result will be used to determine the winner.*
  - 3. The winning team for each age group is the team that finishes in first place in the draw for that event.*
  - 4. If a player forfeits a match after play has started, the opposition will receive all remaining games. For example, if the score is 4-2 to the player who forfeits, the opponent will receive 4 games for the second set with the score ending 2-4 4-0 (10-0) for teams scores only, not individual match results for UTR.*
  - 5. The team with the greater number of rubbers won will be declared the winner of the match. If the number of rubbers won is equal, the team that has won the greater number of sets will be declared the winner. If the number of sets won is equal, the team that has won the greater number of games will be declared the winner. If still equal, then the match will be declared a draw.*
  - 6. For each match won, five (5) points will be awarded to the winning team. In the event of a drawn/incomplete match, each team will be awarded three (3) points. The Losing team will be awarded 1 point, and 1 bonus point for each rubber won per match.*
  - 7. At the completion of the round robin final placings will be determined by:*
    - Total points*
    - Head-to-Head*
    - Rubbers (for and against)*
    - Games (for and against)*
  - 8. For any unresolved scoring issues, a decision will be made in consultation with the event director, referee, and any involved managers.*
  - 9. Trophies will be awarded to members of the winner and runner-up teams of each division.*

# INDIVIDUAL EVENT

*The format will be the best of two tie-break sets with a match tiebreak to be played at one set all in all the events.*

*Players will be expected to play each of their singles matches; if a player is unable to play one of their matches, it is the decision of the event director/referee whether they are permitted to play in any further matches.*

*Winners and finalists in each age group and tier will be awarded trophies*

## **Managers Responsibilities**

- 1. Ensure your team has a designated captain for each match.*
- 2. Ensure all your players are in attendance at least 30 minutes before the start of play.*
- 3. Manage players with any injuries or unavailability.*
- 4. Work with your team members to make sure players are aware of the specified format for each session.*
- 5. Apply the rules and keep matches moving. Ensure warmups are kept to 5 minutes.*
- 6. Have contact numbers of all team members and other managers.*
- 7. Support team captains in ensuring scorecards are completed and returned along with the balls and pencils to the tournament directors.*
- 8. Be on-site throughout all matches*
- 9. Keep matches moving*
- 10. Collect balls, scorecards, and pencils from the event desk.*
- 11. Organise players to the appropriate court.*
- 12. Complete scorecards.*
- 13. Return completed scorecards, pencils, and balls promptly to tournament directors.*

*Tennis Queensland believes that everybody has a responsibility to ensure tournaments are conducted fairly. Please take note of your role below, as there are many things that we can do to create a positive environment for children and young people during tennis tournaments.*

*Any concerns related to child safety should be directed to Tennis Australia's Integrity and Compliance Unit ([integrity@tennis.com.au](mailto:integrity@tennis.com.au)).*

## PLAYER

- Treat all players as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of another player.*
- Be a good sport in victory and defeat. Acknowledge good performances by your opponent.*
- Be fair.*
- Believe in the honesty of your opponents and accept their line calls in matches played without an umpire.*
- If there is any problem during a match with another player, parents, coaches, supporters, or spectators, call for the referee (or court supervisor) to resolve the matter.*
- Physical abuse, verbal abuse, audible obscenities, visible obscenities, or threatening behaviour to a player or any other person is not acceptable or permitted.*
- Be prepared to compete for the scheduled match (ready to play with sunscreen, water bottles, etc., before the match is called to court).*
- Call lines correctly, positively, and verbally. If in doubt, decisions should be made in favour of the opponent. For example, avoid the use of a finger point to call a ball out.*
- Call the score loudly at the end of each point played.*

# PARENT OR GUARDIAN

- *Remember that children play tennis for their enjoyment, not yours.*
- *Remember that children learn best by example. Applaud good play by all players.*
- *Deliberately distracting or intimidating a player is not acceptable or permitted.*
- *Once your child takes to the court, rules prohibit any further communication between players and people outside the court during play. Please ensure your child knows this, so they are not tempted to ask questions during the match. If you do feel you need to ask them something, you may do this with the help of an official.*
- *Support coaches, umpires, and officials.*
- *Focus on your child's efforts and performance - never ridicule or put your child down for making a mistake or losing.*
- *Acknowledge instances of good sportsmanship irrespective of when/where it occurs.*
- *Accept that persons outside the court are not in a good position to judge if line calls made by officials or players are correct.*
- *If you are unable to watch your child compete without becoming involved in disagreements with players, officials, and other non-participants, stay away from the court where your child is playing.*
- *Be enthusiastic, but don't scream instructions from the sideline.*
- *Don't get into shouting matches with anyone.*
- *Never use bad language or harass others.*



# OFFICIAL

- *Ensure a fair contest takes place between the players.*
- *Make fair and consistent decisions about the rules of the game.*
- *Manage and minimise conflict.*
- *Ensure a safe, competitive environment for participation.*
- *Ensure behaviour both on and off the court is consistent with the principle of good sportsmanship.*
- *Resolve any disputes between players in matches played without a chair umpire.*
- *Ensure that the Rules of Tennis and these rules and regulations are observed.*

# EVENT DIRECTOR

- *Tournament Committee/Director.*
- *Be responsible for the overall organisation and administration of the event.*
- *Be responsible for health and safety and child welfare/protection at the tournament and the keeping of good order on the tournament site.*
- *Be responsible for the administration of the tournament office.*
